

## **Performing Arts**

- Year 10 have been involved with planning the curriculum map for the rest of the year in GCSE Drama.
- Invited to take part in Academy Production performing or work backstage
- Students get invited to extra Music sessions as a group or one to one
- Dance Club have a leader/choreographer role in the process of creating a dance and assist lower ability students attending the Club
- Music Club have the opportunity to run their own club, it is their choice to whether they take this opportunity on board
- In Music they are used as lead learners, in Drama they are used as Directors and dance they are Choreographers.
- They assist with others in the group and give demonstrations of good practice and raising the attainment in the class
- GCSE G&T Students get given technical movements to add to their work and performances, suggest ideas for performances
- Facilities are available for them to book and use to work on their abilities.
- Showcases that demonstrate their work and progression in their chosen art form.

### **Physical** Education

- Set Students in PE so that once assessed the most able work in the same groups, this allows them to push themselves physically and mentally.
- Encourage all of these Students to attend Enrichment Clubs to enhance their development further
- Run Gifted and Talented days for year 6 and 7 students
