Keep you and your mobile safe

The video clip focuses on people who leave their mobiles on view on tables when they're out.

It is a common sight to see a group of people in a pub, club or restaurant with their mobile phones on a table.

A thief sees a mobile as a cash opportunity and people make it easy for them to steal them by leaving them on view. It only takes seconds for it to be stolen. It is also easy for people to get up from the table and leave their phone there. Some top phones can cost up to £500.

We urge everyone to be cautious, be aware of the potential risk and keep themselves and their property safe.

To help reduce the risks keep your phone safe and hidden from view on your person. Don't leave bags hanging on a chair or on the floor.

Alcohol can severely affect your ability to make safe judgements, so before a night out plan how you're getting home. Nominate a designated driver or book a taxi and make sure your phone cannot fall out of your pocket.

People are urged to register their phone and mobile data devices for free on www.immobilise.com for the best chance of getting it back if lost or stolen. You just need your IMEI number which can be found by dialling *#06# and serial numbers for your other devices.

If police recover lost or stolen property they check the database and can return the item to the rightful owner.
