OOVVOO

It has been brought to our attention that many students are using oovoo, a video chat site, to contact each other. Unfortunately many students have been contacted by undesirable characters who have then sent them indecent images. This has been reported to the police and there is an ongoing investigation into this. We are encouraging all students to deactivate their oovoo accounts or at the very least change their security settings to ensure that strangers cannot contact them. 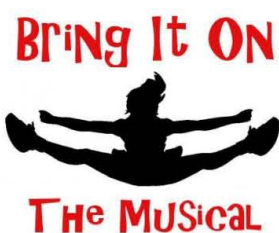


Performing Arts finished the term of with 'Bring It On: The Musical'.
