

- All GCSEs will have at least one exam at the end of the course. For most subjects this will be the only method of assessment.

- To achieve this English Baccalaureate qualification, students must take: Spanish and Geography or Spanish and History






## Some important points

- Try to encourage a variety in their choices this will allow more choice at Post 16.

- We can not guarantee that an individual course will run.

- · They think it will help them get a job at 16.




 Regular attendance and good punctuality are crucial.

 Students with poor attendance find it hard to catch up.







At Landau Forte Academy Amington we offer a curriculum for our students that will prepare them to continue into Post-16 education and beyond, or employment with training. We will provide a range of appropriate qualifications for students according to their individual needs and strengths

Through the curriculum, students will develop extensive knowledge and understanding, increasing their competence in a wide range of skills, ensuring that they are equipped to progress into Post-16 education and eventually higher education or employment with training.

Students cannot select the same subject in both pots

However, this is sometimes not possible, either because the combinations will not fit into the timetable or because not enough people have chosen a subject for it to run and therefore we cannot guarantee individual courses will run. That is why we ask you to make a reserve choice which we will use if we have to. We may also feel it appropriate to make changes to pathways or choices as the year goes on. If we do, we will contact you.






