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Behaviour Policy Amendments

As we near the halfway point of this term, I am writing to you to outline some amendments to the current behaviour policy. Students have settled in well to the 'new normal' of Academy life and are coping well with the changes to the Academy day. To ensure we maintain a purposeful learning environment and provide support consistency in expectations and allow all students access learning in a calm and focussed environment.

Key changes include:

- Logging of C1 and C2 sanctions in order to tract low level disruption and provide interventions where required.
- C3 detention replaced with 'session support' from a Pastoral or Progress Leader, this will allow for timely intervention and ensure students remain in lessons accessing learning. Parents will be informed of C3 session support via Edulink message.
- Equipment detentions – students will have the opportunity during Personal Tutor time to ensure they are equipped for the day with stationery being available to purchase from the Pastoral Support Office. Students will require: black/blue pen, pencil, ruler, green pen, house lanyard (which must be worn at all times) PE kit for PE days.
If a student fails to arrive at lessons with the appropriate equipment, they will be issued with a 20 minute detention (one equipment detention per day).

C4 is a 40 minute detention, multiple C4's in one day and late detentions remain unchanged.

As you are aware, following Government guidelines, students are required to wear masks in all communal areas. It is imperative that your child has a mask and is wearing it before they enter the Academy building. Many students are wearing single use masks, which are fine, however, we would urge you to supply a re-usable mask if possible as these are more durable and kinder to the environment.

As ever, we appreciate your support in ensuring Amington students fulfil our vales of being Ambitious, Brave and Kind.

C2	Continued low level disruption	Second formal warning. Logged to track low level disruption Improvement in behaviour no further action needed.
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C3 – Session support Edulink message to parent to inform them their child received a C3 and session support.	Repeat or continuation of C2 or: An action or incident that the teacher feels warrants intervention or support	Session support will remove and mediate and support the student in modifying behaviour Student will be returned to lesson Incident logged as a C3 Improvement in behaviour no further action is needed.
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C4 — 40 minute detention 2 C4s in one day issues a 1hour detention	Repeat or continuation of C3 or: Putting the safety of others at risk. Session Support are unable to get the student back into lesson.	Student will be removed from the lesson Incident logged as a C4.
S1	Student breaks Safety Protocols Student purposefully performs an unhygienic action. Failure to wear mask in the building	Log Incident as an S1

The primary aim is for all students to be in lesson and accessing learning at all times. Students who fail to reach our behaviour expectations will follow the C system.

Pastoral staff are allocated to each 'bubble' to support teaching staff in managing behaviour and supporting students where appropriate.
