So what is a Curriculum Vitae?



A CURRICULUM VITAE (CV) IS A SUMMARY OF YOUR EDUCATION AND CAREER. YOU WILL USE A CV TO APPLY FOR JOBS AND WORK EXPERIENCE. EVEN IF YOU ARE APPLYING ON AN APPLICATION FORM, IT IS MORE LIKELY YOU WILL GET NOTICED IF YOU HAND A CV IN FIRST OR WITH YOUR APPLICATION FORM.

DON'T BE TEMPTED TO USE THE TEMPLATES FROM THE INTERNET AS THEY ARE NOT USUALLY APPROPRIATE FOR YOUR AGE AND EXPERIENCE.

A CV should contain the following.....



* **CONTACT DETAILS** - YOU'RE NOT LIKELY TO BE HIRED IF EMPLOYERS CANNOT EVEN GET HOLD OF YOU.

* **A PERSONAL STATEMENT**- (TALK ABOUT YOUR PERSONAL SKILLS- POSITIVE THINGS ABOUT YOUR PERSONALITY SUCH AS BEING PUNCTUAL, TRUSTWORTHY, CONFIDENT ETC.....
WHAT ARE YOUR ASPIRATIONS? WHAT DO YOU WANT TO BECOME? WHAT MOTIVATES YOU?)

* **KEY SKILLS AND ABILITIES** - (TALK ABOUT YOUR SKILLS SUCH AS WHAT YOU CAN DO- GOOD WITH COMPUTERS, NUMERACY SKILLS, CREATIVE)

* **YOUR QUALIFICATIONS** - (LIST THE SUBJECTS YOU ARE TAKING AND YOUR PREDICTED GRADES IF YOU HAVE THEM)

* **ACHIEVEMENTS** - (PREFECT, WORK EXPERIENCE, AWARDS, TROPHIES)

Personal Statement

(Talk about your personal skills- positive things about your personality such as being punctual, trustworthy, confident etc.....

(Harborne Academy Address and the Years you are here for)

Your Qualifications

(List the subjects you are taking and your predicted grades if you have them)

Achievements

(Prefect, Work Experience, Awards, Trophies)

Interests

(Sports, Outside clubs or groups, leisure, computers, crafts)
