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Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for your patience and support throughout this challenging time. I write to you with the good news that for one week we have had no further positive cases of Covid-19 or additional staff being required to self-isolate. To this end, **all students will be welcomed back to learning in the Academy on Monday 7th December.**

I appreciate how our community has embraced the remote learning offer and I am pleased to report that this has enabled our Year 11 students to successfully complete a full suite of mock examinations. These examinations are absolutely crucial in order for those students to be prepared for their external examinations in the summer. I wish to congratulate our Year 11 students on their attitude and maturity in these unusual circumstances. We are all so proud of their resilience and willingness to adapt to these unprecedented times.

Our hope now is that we can minimise any disruption for all students in the coming weeks and months but although our remote learning offer appears to have broken any potential chain of infection in the Academy, we all know that Covid-19 remains prevalent in our local community. We must all do our very best to follow the Government guidance in order to reduce the risk from Covid-19 and to ensure we do all we can to keep one another safe. On the Academy site, at the most basic level, this means that all students must regularly wash their hands or use the hand sanitiser that is available; wear a mask in all communal areas; always remain within the year group bubble; and maintain social distancing, where possible, in particular from staff members.

For clarity, all students will return to full time provision on Monday 7th December, in full school uniform or PE kit if they have PE on that day; this is a Week B on our timetable.
