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Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the latest Government announcement, from Tuesday 5th January, on-site provision at Landau Forte Amington will only be available for vulnerable students and the children of key workers. Places have been confirmed individually with each family based upon criteria set out by Government.

For the limited number of students that will be on-site, our Covid-19 protocols, including building entry and exit points, will remain in place and the staggered start and finish times are indicated below:

In addition, some students in Year 11 have imminent external examinations and we will be contacting those effected individually.

We are today seeking clarification from the Department for Education with regards to the on-site Covid-19 testing of students and staff which was due to begin in January. Once we have received further guidance, we may be in touch to request formal written consent for your child to be tested as part of the national effort of infection control.

For those students who are being asked to learn from home in the coming weeks, the Academy will be providing an offer which will be familiar to all students, building on the trials and processes we implemented earlier in the school year. Having listened to feedback from the previous period of lockdown, we have enhanced our provision to include the full curriculum and a daily pastoral session for all students. Our remote learning timetable is attached at the end of this letter, and is available through MS Teams, beginning today, on Tuesday, Week B.

At this stage we do not know for how long the Academy will be closed, but we are ready to offer our remote learning provision for as long as is required. We recognise this is a challenging time for everyone and we greatly appreciate the ongoing support from our families and our local community. I understand that you may have questions and as always, I encourage you to contact your child's Progress Leader via EduLink in the first instance.
