For most subjects, the DNA will be clearly shown in books.

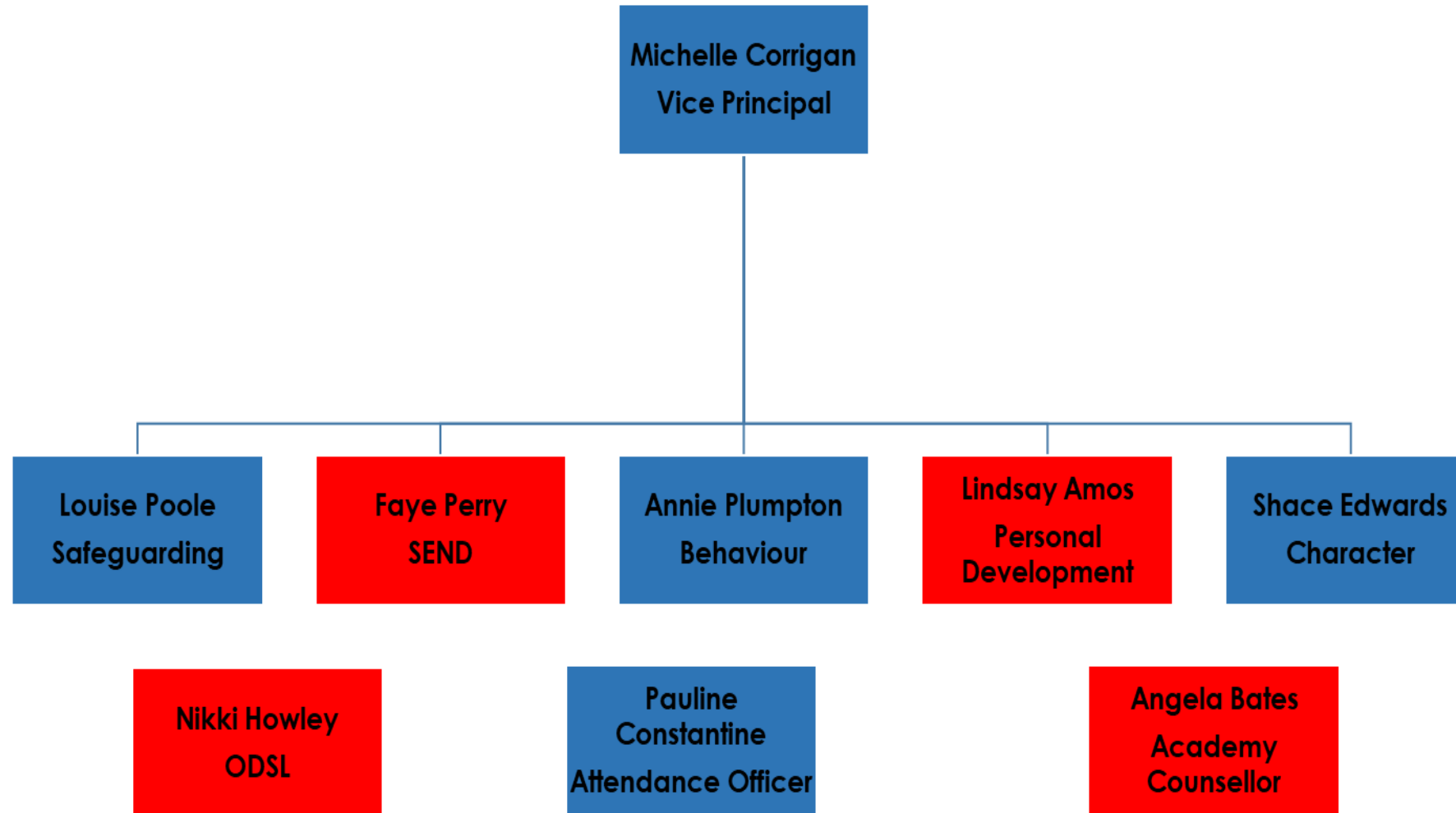

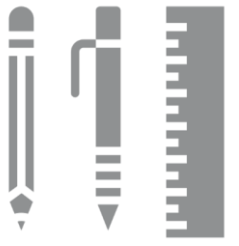
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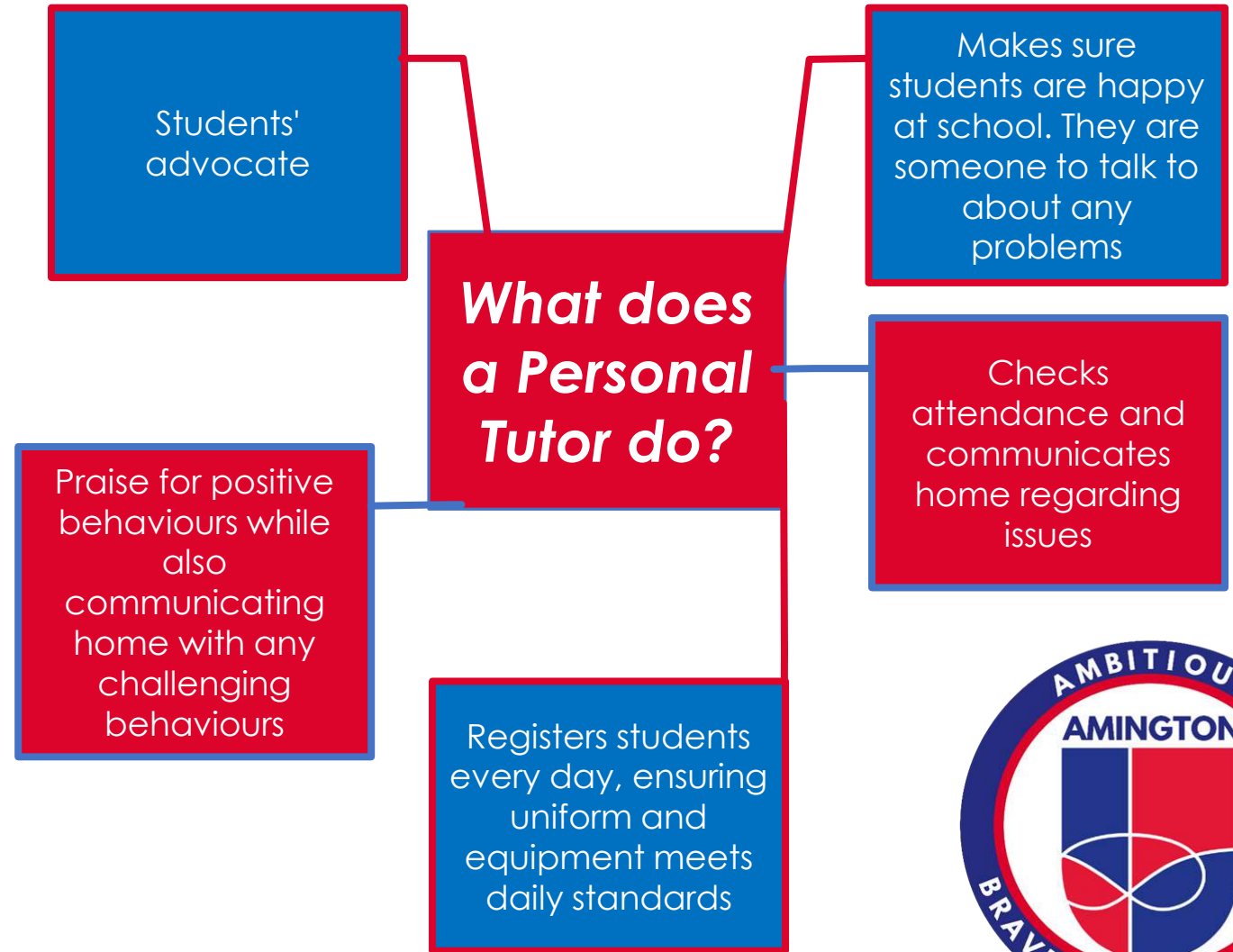


Personal Tutor System

Attendance

This motto perfectly encompasses the key values of both house Kilimanjaro and Amington as an academy.



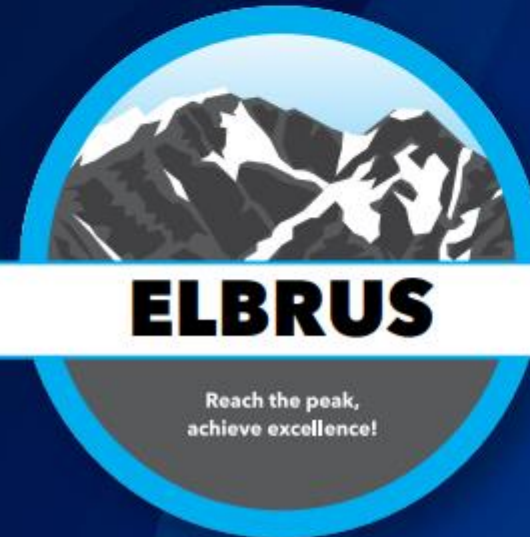

We expect students to come equipped with a bag and a pencil case. Our stationery requirements are:

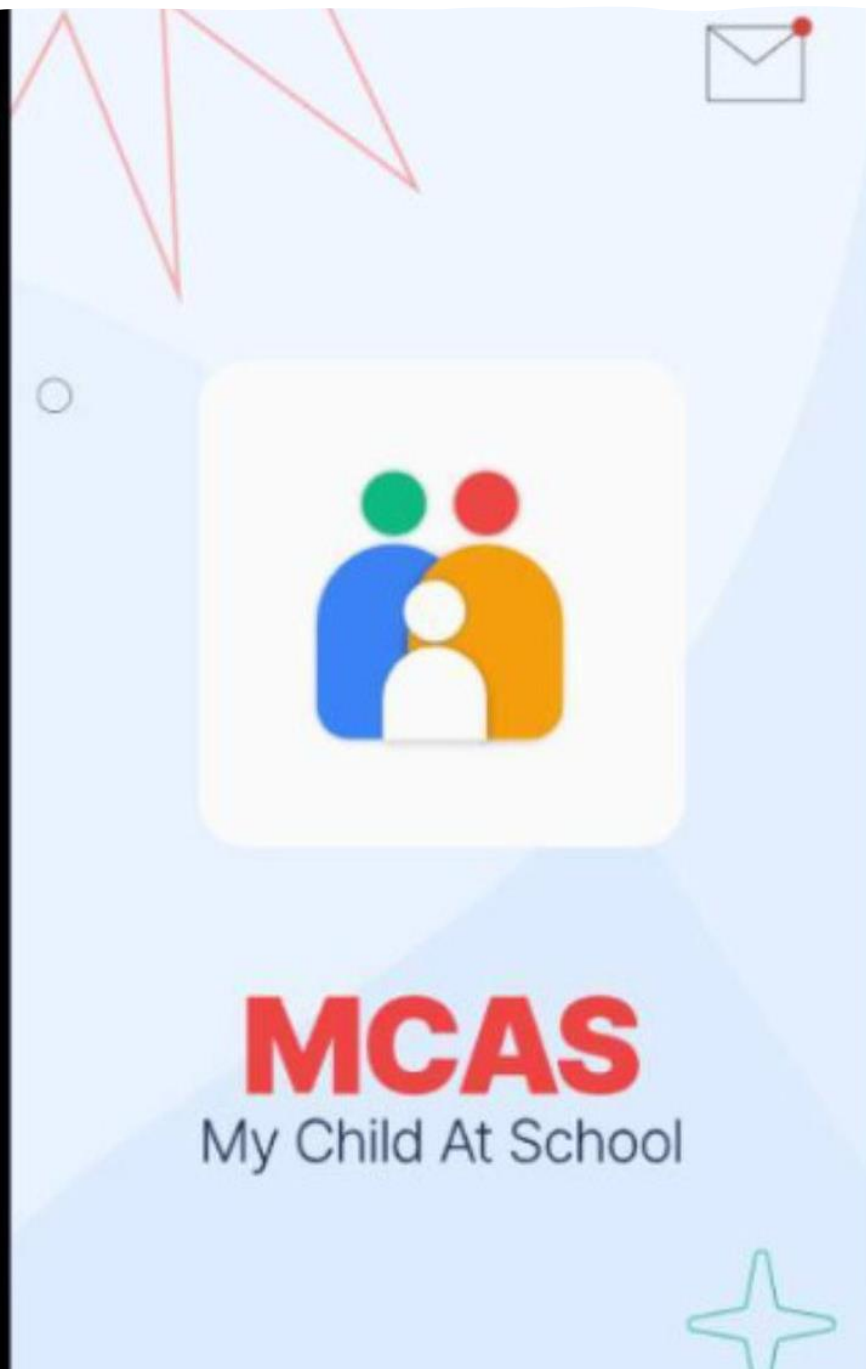

- In their first two days, every child will be fed free of charge.





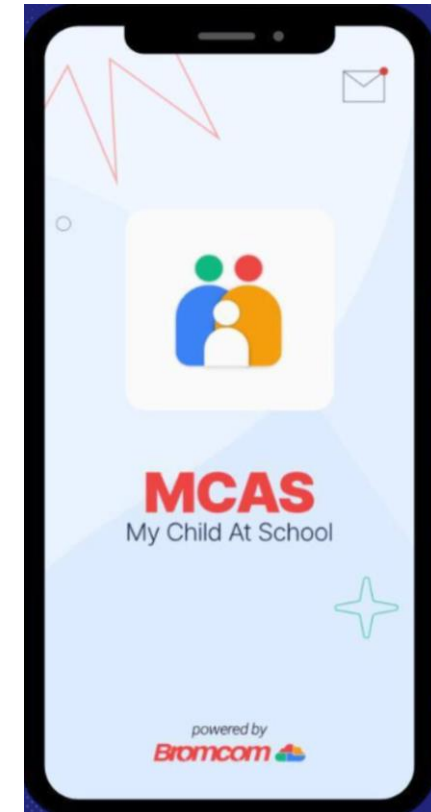
