In our first unit of the GCSE we study the causes and consequences of uneven development

During term three we take a journey through Africa. Here we study a variety of countries including Kenya.

As part of our desert topic we focus Northern Africa and USA. We then study a contrasting desert in Antarctica.



Students complete a country study of Russia. We will learn about energy production and the Arctic trading route.

In term two students study global hazards, including the causes and impacts.
